Development of Anti-Corruption Three Credit Hours Course

In May 2016, The AACI and Aqaba University of Technology (AUT) signed an unprecedented agreement in the Middle East and Africa to develop an anti-corruption three credit hours course to offer it at AUT as a required course to all its students.

The course contents, design, and mode of delivery are innovative and respond to what academia needs to play a proactive role in preventing fraud and corruption.

AUT will market this course to the Jordanian universities as well as Arab and African universities. This agreement comes as a result of the “general agreement” the two parties signed earlier last March.
